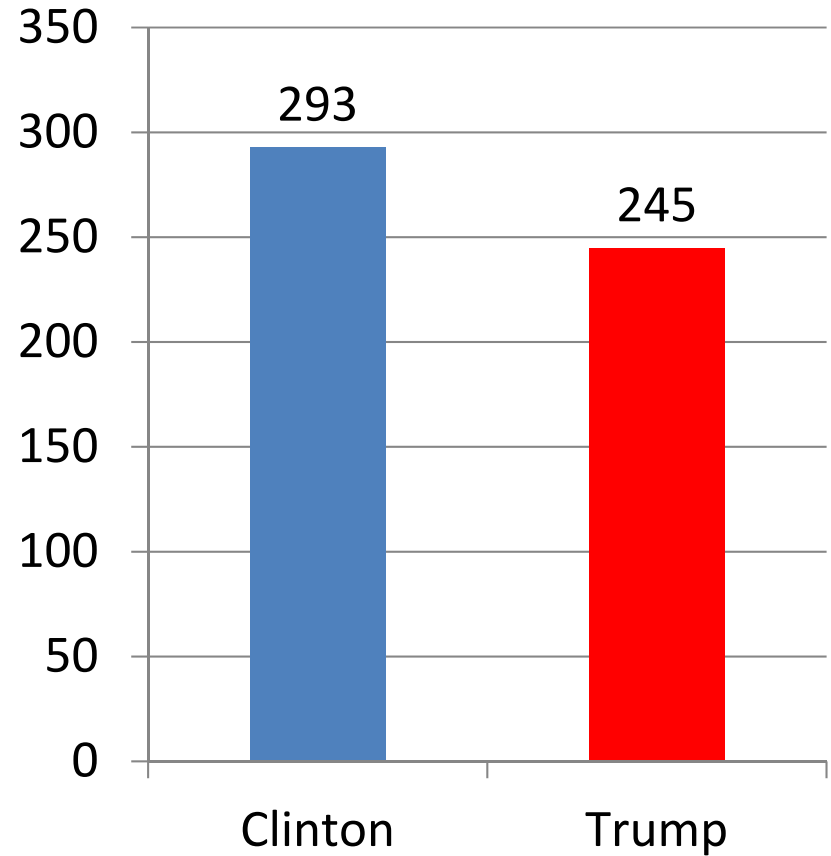
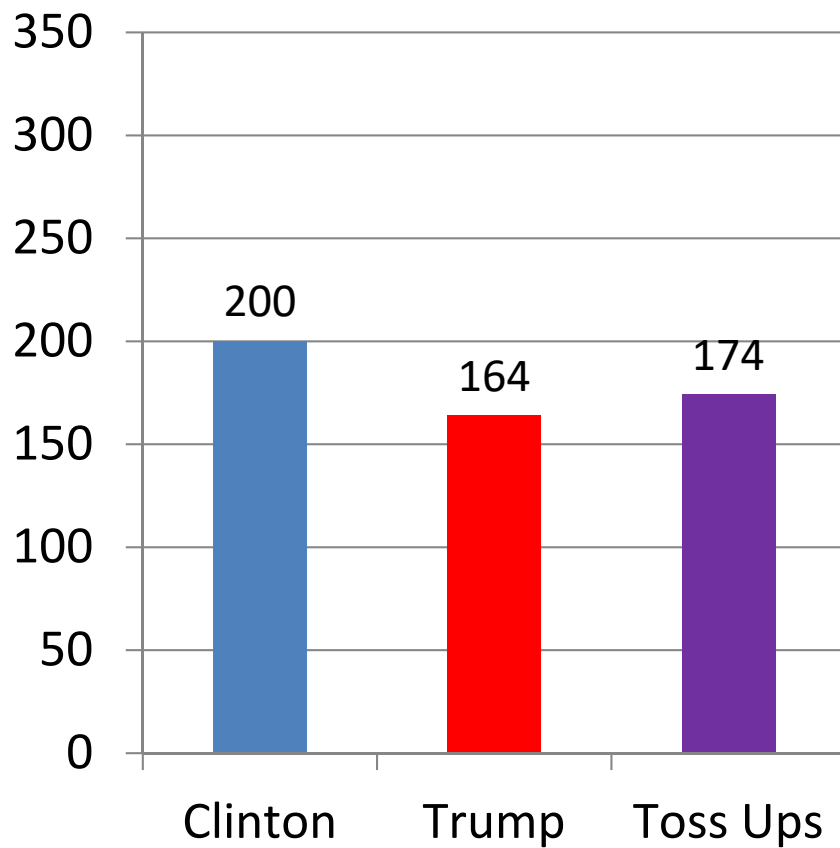
# RealClearPolitics Average: Tracking Poll

# Electoral College Projection

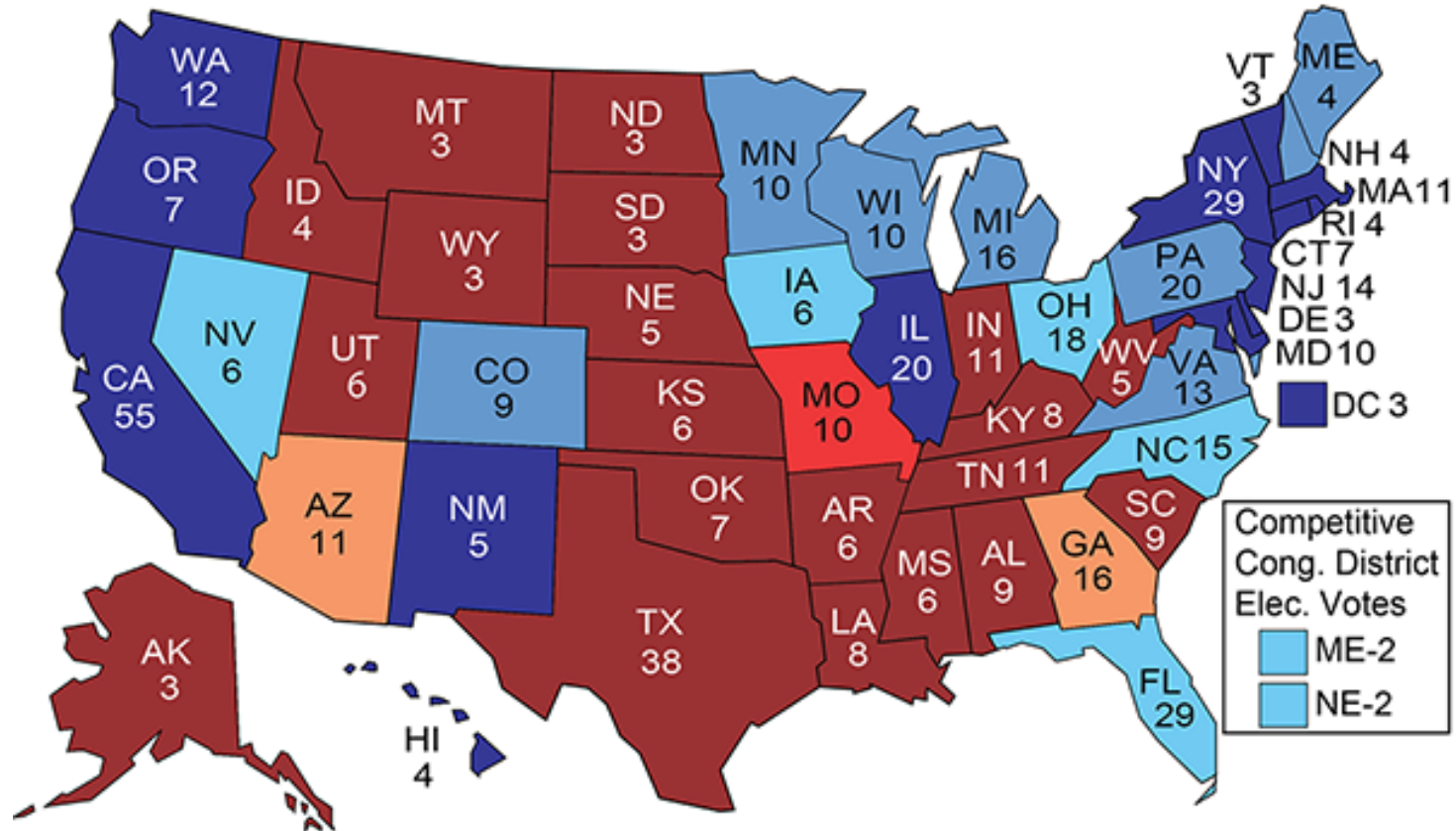

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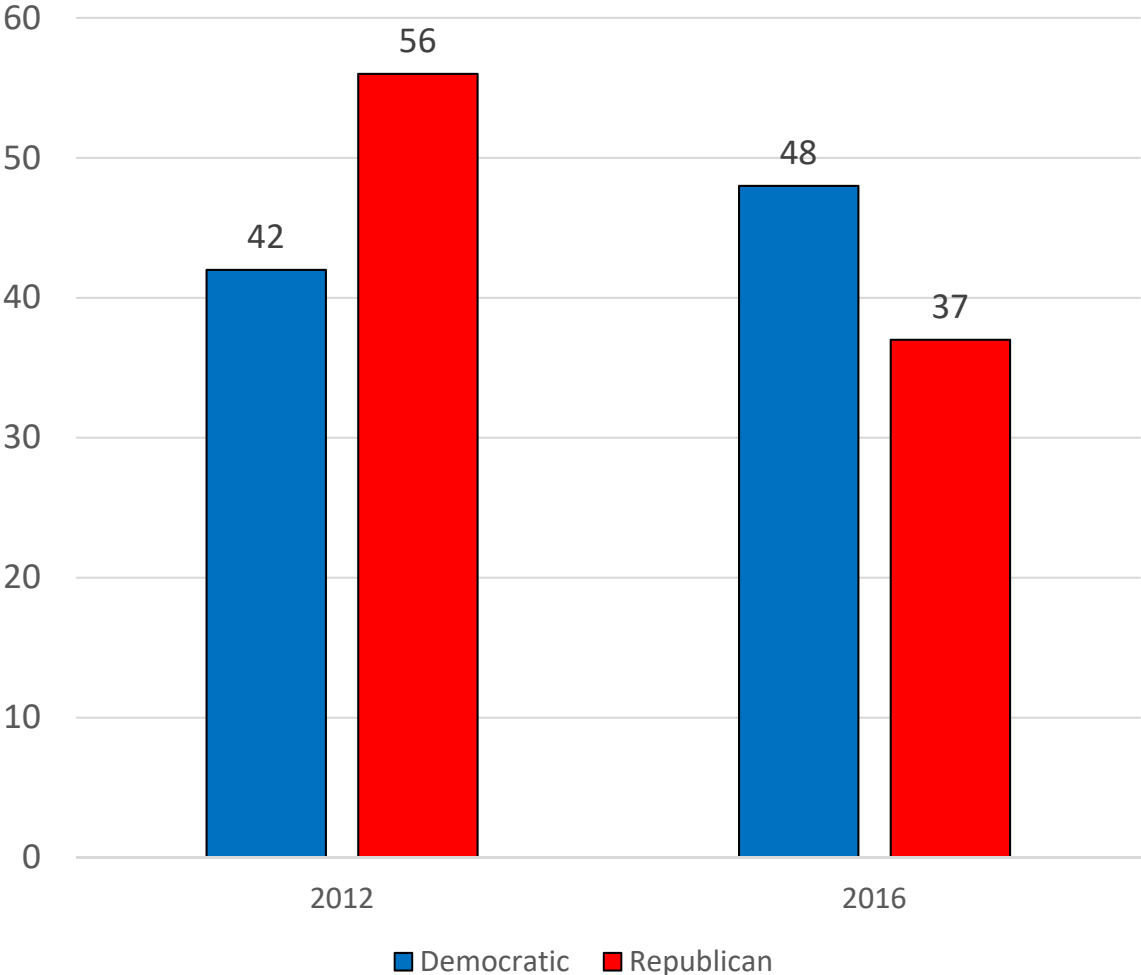

# College Educated Whites: Vote for Presidential Nominee by Party: 2012 v. 2016

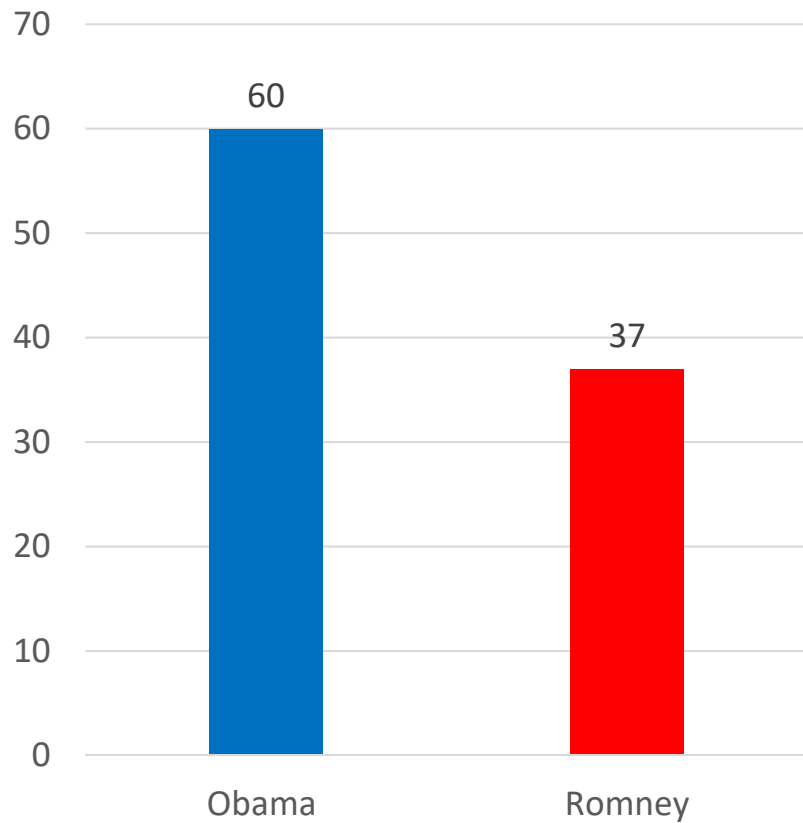

# Youth Vote: 2012

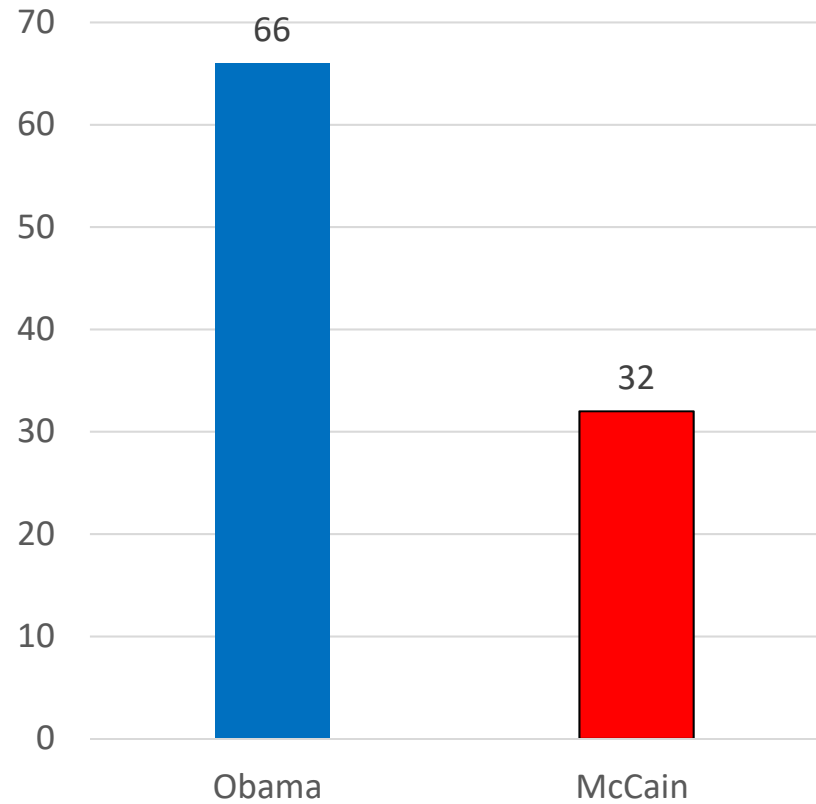
2012 Election: Under 30

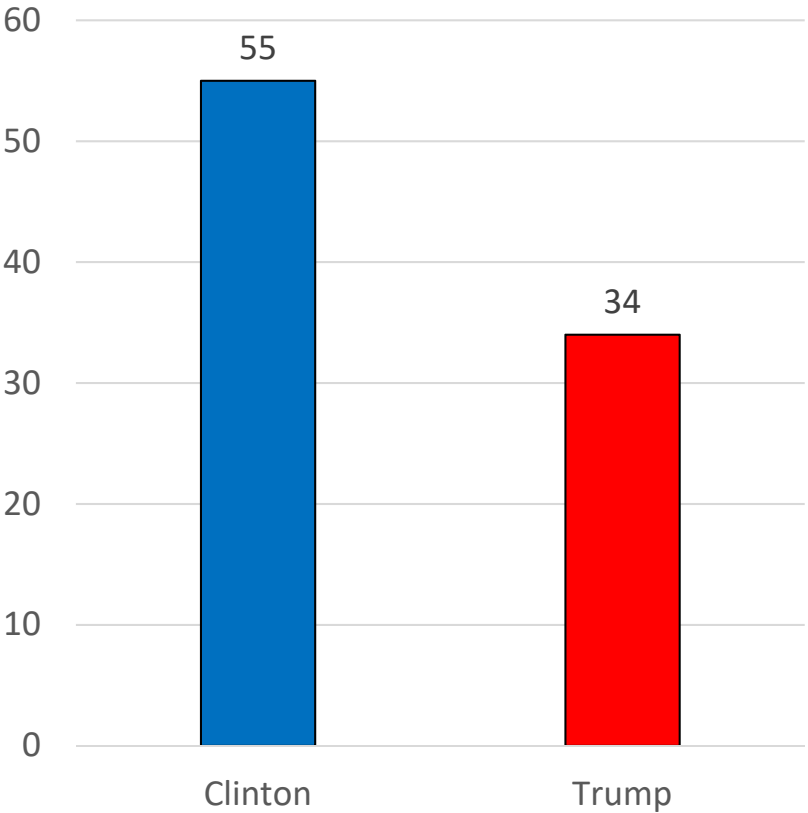
2008 Election: Under 30

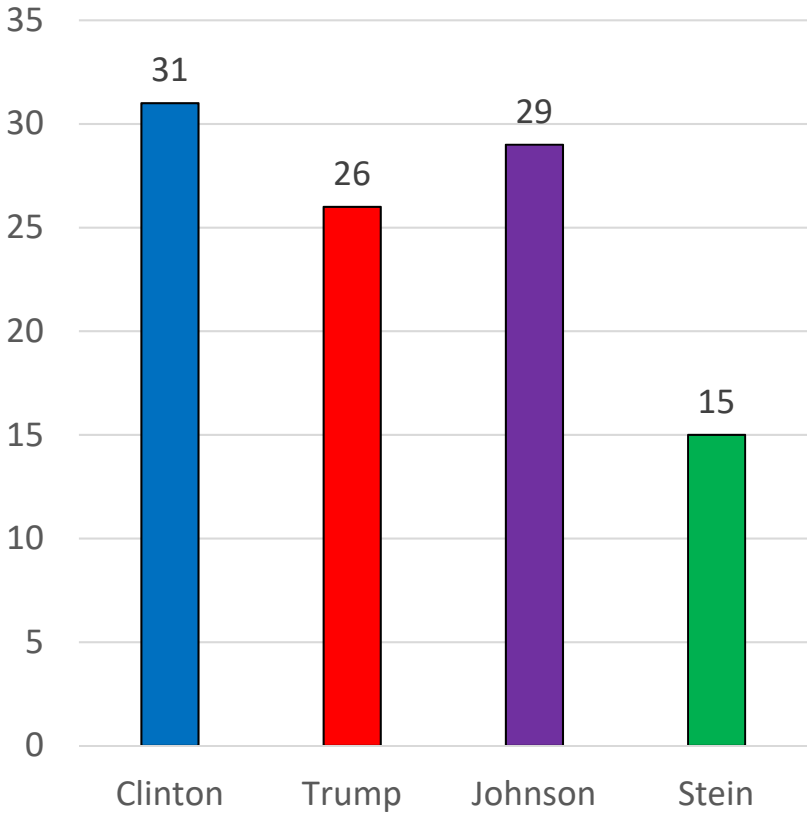


# Youth Vote: 2016

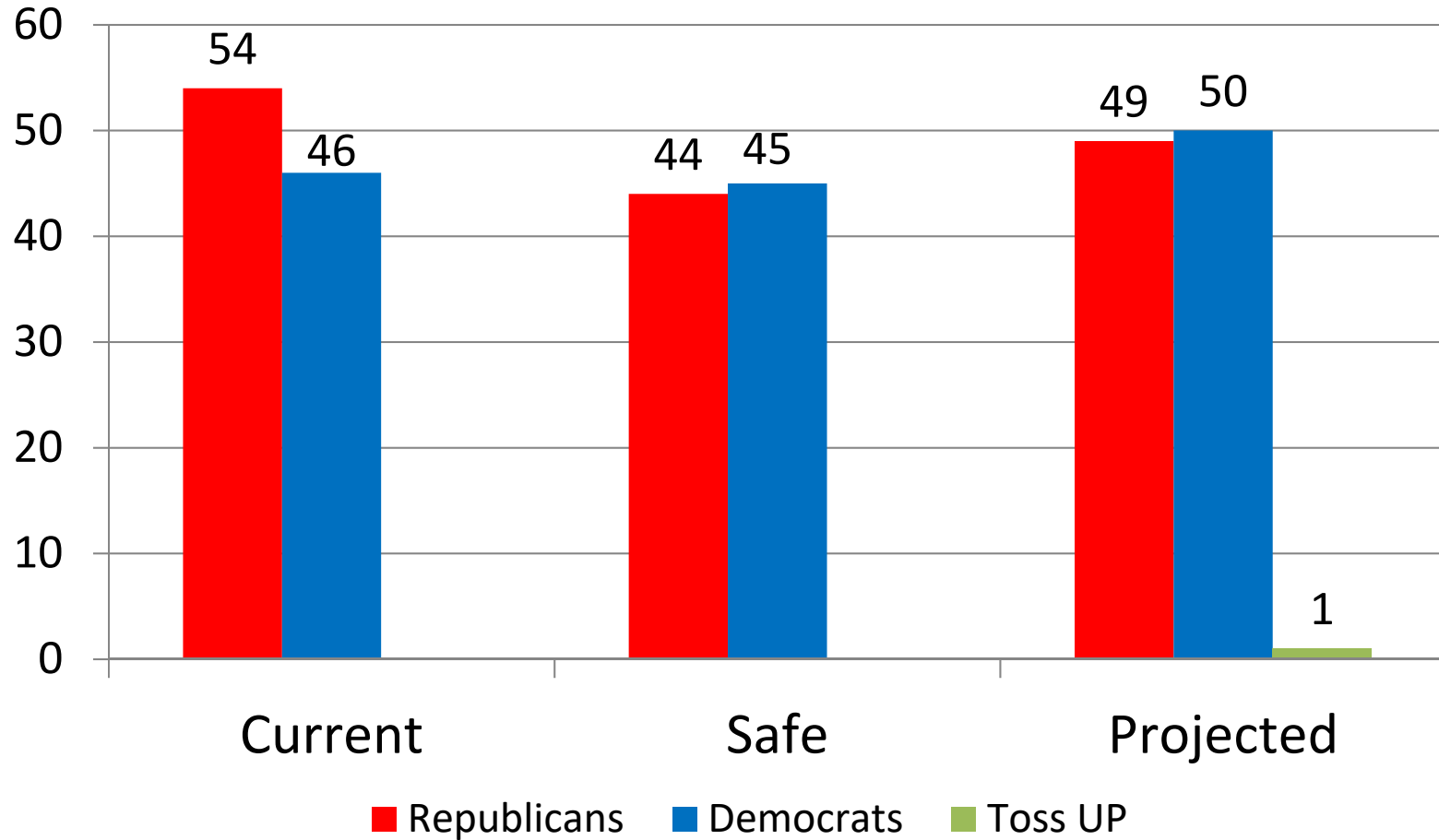

-Projected **10-15 seat gain for Democrats**; short of the 30 to win a majority.

-Toss ups **14 GOP** **2 Democrats**;

**-Leans GOP 8; Leans Democrat 9;**

I-VA, Comstock in the 10<sup>th</sup> **leans GOP**; VA 5<sup>th</sup>, open/Hurt, **likely GOP**

VA 4<sup>th</sup> (Forbes), **Safe Democrat**
